*Many Congratulations to the 58th Cub Pack, who won this year's District Outdoor Competition, and to the 62nd and 48th Cub Packs who came joint second!*



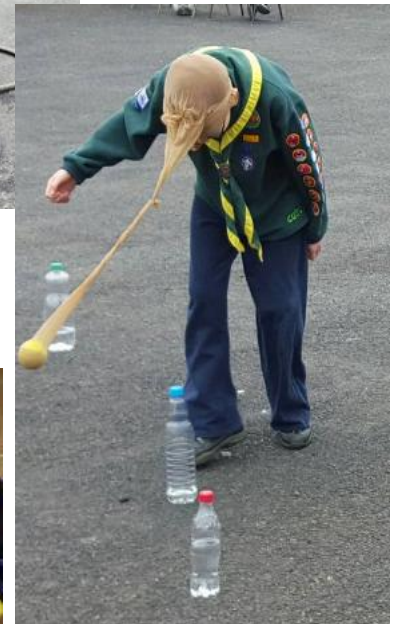
