The County Executive have concluded a recent consultation with Trustees, Employees and the Leadership Team, during which, in addition to the present arrangements, the following points were considered:

- Meetings of County Teams no longer utilise CHQ due to the remote location
- Costs associated with maintaining and running CHQ all year round
- Engagement with Partner Organisations would be easier and more effective from Liverpool City Centre
- Increased security and improved surroundings for our employees
- Central location for meetings of an evening and weekend

The County Executive, following the consultation, have approved a new location for County Office that meets the present and future needs of Merseyside Scouts and our members.

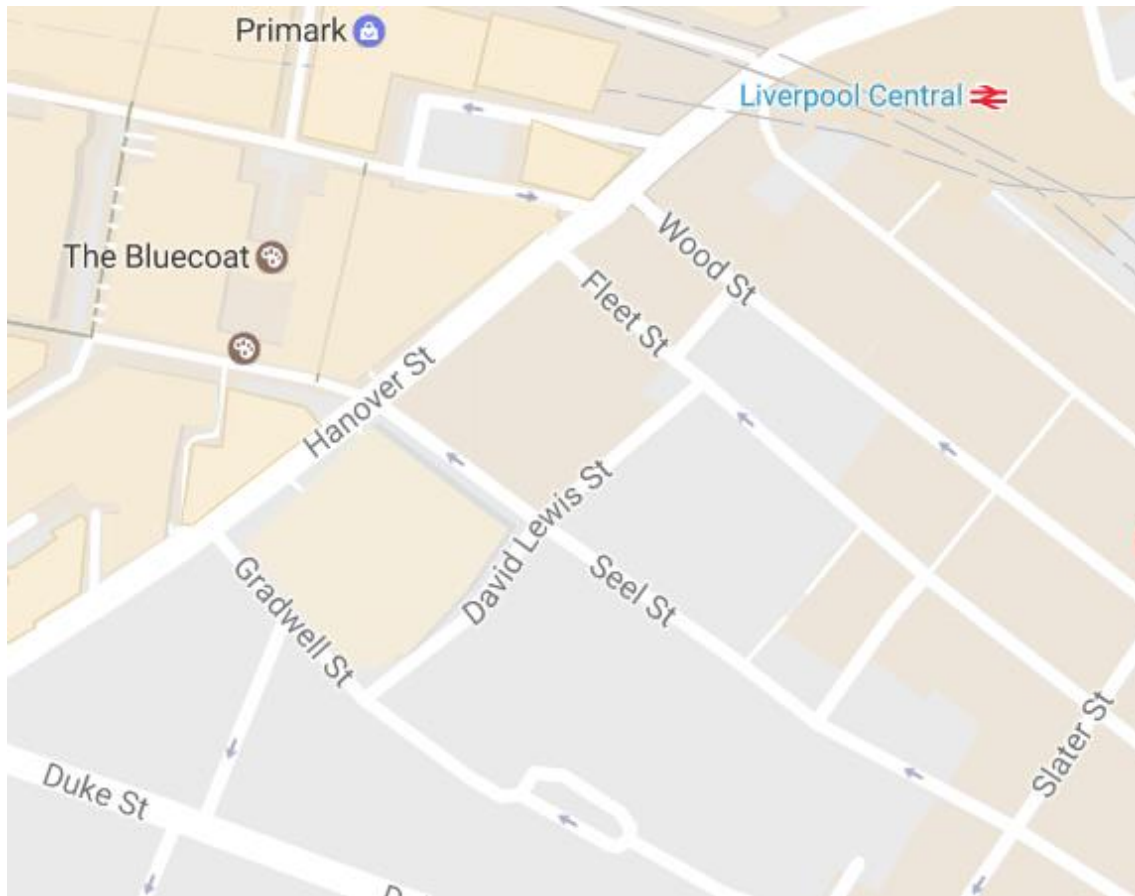
## Merseyside Scouts County Office is Moving

### What's happening and Why?

For a number of years the County Leadership team have believed that there would be benefits in re-locating CHQ back to Liverpool Centre.

- County Office was previously based in Liverpool City Centre for many years
- We moved to Tawd Vale when the Bungalow was no longer required as a residence for the Warden, in 2009.
- CHQ is isolated from the centre of the County
- Lone working adjustments required a change to our operational hours
- IT connectivity is currently very poor and becoming unsuitable for our requirements – and difficult to support by remote volunteers
